Comprehensive and systematic courses in Bible Study are offered. As the Holy Spirit takes the things of Christ and reveals them to us, we can expect rich blessings.

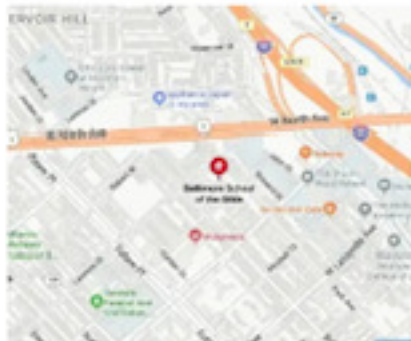
In order to achieve the widest possible reach, the classes are open to all.

In these days of confusion and uncertainty, the student will find encouragement and comfort in the unchanging and authoritative Word of God.



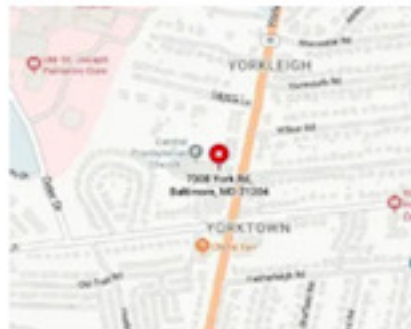

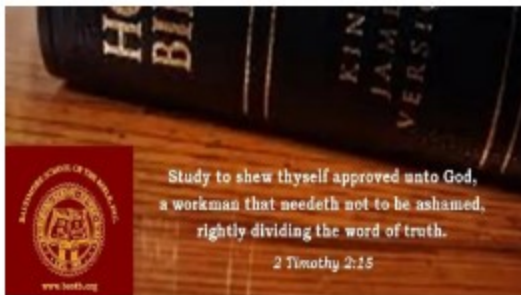

### Courses and Credits

Visitors are cordially invited to attend a class session. For the greatest benefit, however, the School recommends enrollment as a regular student for credit, if at all possible.

In order to receive credit for any course, the student must complete all requirements given by the instructor in the course syllabus. The student is also required to meet the attendance requirements as explained in the school catalog. A grade of 65 or more is needed to pass and receive one credit for that class per semester.

Baltimore School of the Bible offers a variety of courses that will provide the student with a strong foundation of biblical knowledge and understanding. In addition, a few courses are offered during a six-week summer mini-semester.

There is a nominal registration fee of \$150 plus the cost of books.

### General Bible Courses

The course work is designed to give the student a true working knowledge of the Word of God to prepare him/her for work in their own church or where ever our Lord may lead. Upon completion of 36 credits of the required courses, the student is awarded a BSOTB Diploma and Evangelical Training Association (ETA) Certificates.
